

If your subscription includes 24/7 access for students and parents, help extend learning at home. Plus, our activities are fun for the whole family!

Game Show Each BrainPOP movie includes a quiz to assess comprehension. Parents can turn taking the quiz into a family game show by having “contestants” press a buzzer or ring a bell as they race to share answers.

Know More Each BrainPOP topic includes a Q & A feature with related questions. Encourage students to write their own question at home and see if they can find the answer on BrainPOP.

Vocabulary Charades Advise students to review vocabulary at home with the Vocabulary Activity Pages associated with each topic. Families can make a charades game out of the topic related words by writing the words and definitions on note cards. Family members can then take turns drawing a note card from a hat and acting out the word.

Did You Know? Delve further into the topic with the FYI feature found on each BrainPOP topic page. This feature provides high quality informational text that can be used to reinforce a variety of reading and comprehension skills. It’s great for research, too!

Laugh Out Loud Add a little humor with our Cassie and Rita comic located in each FYI section. Encourage students to create their own comic based on the daily BrainPOP topic.

Spotlight Every month BrainPOP offers two timely “Spotlights,” which are collections of themed topics. Have students view the Spotlights’ movies at home, then apply what they’ve learned by producing a digital story with technology-based tools.
